### BACKGROUND

These licence fees are for articles supplied by companies that provide document delivery services for their clients. Copyright Agency licenses these services to supply members' articles in accordance with authority from its members.

The total amount for distribution is approximately \$29,196

- EBSCO: \$16,245 (January to December 2016)
- ProQuest: \$12,932 (January to December 2016)

EBSCO and ProQuest provide Copyright Agency with data about works supplied under their document delivery services.

### ALLOCATION OF LICENCE FEES

Licence fees are allocated to rightsholders who have authorised Copyright Agency to license their works for inclusion in the document delivery services. Recipients are required to check that allocations to them align with their rights, and to share payments in accordance with their contractual obligations.
