
DISTRIBUTION OF LICENCE FEES FROM NSW GOVERNMENT FOR SALE OF PLANS

November 2017

BACKGROUND

These licence fees are for the sale of survey plans by the New South Wales Government, and by commercial information brokers authorised by the New South Wales Government, from October to December 2016. The licence fees are based on the number of plans sold in that period, and a [determination by the Copyright Tribunal](#) that set a royalty of 12.5% of the sale price.

DATA FOR DISTRIBUTION

The distribution is based on data provided by the New South Wales Government for each over-the-counter sale, and each electronic sale referable to a copyright owner represented by Copyright Agency, for the licence period (October to December 2016).

Plans in which copyright is owned by the Commonwealth or a State government are excluded from the distribution.

ALLOCATION OF LICENCE FEES TO RIGHTSHOLDERS

Licence fees have been allocated to rightsholders in accordance with information available to us, including plan numbers provided by members and surveyors' employment history. Recipients are required to check that allocations to them align with their rights.

A portion of the licence fees has been allocated to non-members. This amount will be held in trust pending identification and membership of copyright owners for the plans.
