

**2016 DISTRIBUTION OF LICENCE FEES FROM RELIGIOUS ORGANISATIONS**

June 2016

The 2016 distribution of licence fees from religious organisations is based on:

- the results of a ‘high level’ survey of religious organisations licensees about the types of content they use under the licence; and
- ‘indicative data’ about content that is available for use by religious organisations under the licence.

The amount distributed is approximately \$400,000.

The distribution is for text only. A portion of the licence fees attributable to use of images is being distributed as part of the ‘combined’ distribution of licence fees for images from multiple sources.

We allocated the licence fees by:

1. Apportioning the licence fees into ‘pools’ for books and newspapers/magazines;
2. Identifying the best currently available sources of data for each pool; and
3. Selecting data from each source

The sources of data were:

<b>Books</b>	Titles held in libraries, and titles listed in Copyright Agency’s database, that have similar subject matter to titles recorded in past surveys of usage in religious organisations.
<b>Newspapers &amp; magazines</b>	Digital press clippings supplied to religious organisations.

**SHARING PAYMENTS**

We send recipients a [payment summary](#) and a [payment spreadsheet](#) with each payment. If there is information on the spreadsheet that identifies a publication or work and an obligation to share the payment, then you should share that payment in accordance with your contractual obligations. You are not required to share with rightsholders of images, however, given that there will be a separate distribution for images.
