

DISTRIBUTION OF LICENCE FEES FROM OVERSEAS COLLECTING SOCIETIES

September 2016

BACKGROUND

Copyright Agency is affiliated with similar bodies in other countries that collect copyright licensing fees for the use of Australian content.¹ This distribution comprises licence fees from 15 affiliated societies, totaling approximately \$1.7M. The licence fees are for different licence periods in the country of origin, ranging from 2008 to 2016.

DATA FOR DISTRIBUTION

Each of the foreign societies provided data for distribution with these licence fees. There are two types of data:

- the names of people to whom the foreign society has allocated licence fees in accordance with its distribution policies and law (together with information about their works); and
- information about works to which the licence fees relate, which Copyright Agency links to rightsholders through its research.
