
DISTRIBUTION OF LICENCE FEES FOR INFORMIT DATABASES

September 2016

BACKGROUND

These licence fees are for the inclusion of articles in the Informit databases managed by RMIT Publishing.

The total amount for distribution is approximately \$929,000, for the licence period January to December 2015:

- APAFT (Australian Public Affairs Full Text):¹ \$325,000
- A-PLUS (education research):² \$128,000
- AGIS (legal research): \$240,000
- Collections:³ \$236,000

DATA FOR DISTRIBUTION

Informit provides Copyright Agency with access to data about each work that subscribers have accessed during the licence period (January to December 2015). This distribution also includes some data about works accessed in 2014 that was omitted from the dataset for the previous distribution.

ALLOCATION OF LICENCE FEES

Licence fees are allocated to rightsholders who have authorised Copyright Agency to license their works for inclusion in the Informit databases. Recipients are required to check that allocations to them align with their rights.
