	The distribution is based on data indicating articles available for copying and sharing by these licensees, for which the writers have retained copyright. The distribution will be implemented in two processes, to allow for the different tax treatment of statutory and non-statutory licence fees respectively.	
2. CHANGES SINCE PREVIOUS DISTRIBUTION	This is the first time that we have allocated payments to writers of journal articles in this way.	
3. FUNDS FOR DISTRIBUTION	Amount (approx.)	\$0.53m
	How calculated	Licence fees allocated for journal contributors from each of the above sources, less deductions for projected operating costs and Cultural Fund .
