1. BACKGROUND	This distribution comprises licence fees from the following sources for articles published in newspapers and magazines, in which contributors retain entitlement to Copyright Agency payments.

The distribution is based on data indicating articles available for copying and sharing by these licensees, for which the writers have retained copyright. The distribution will be implemented in two processes, to allow for the different tax treatment of statutory and non-statutory licence fees respectively.			
2. OBLIGATION TO SHARE PAYMENTS	There is no obligation to share payments. Recipients will see 'Works under licence' on their payment spreadsheet (remittance advice), with two amounts: one for government and education, and one for corporations and associations, reflecting the licence fee sources above.		
3. CHANGES SINCE PREVIOUS DISTRIBUTION	This is the first time we have allocated payments to newspaper contributors in this way.		
4. FUNDS FOR DISTRIBUTION	Amount (approx.)	\$1.66m	
	How calculated	Licence fees allocated for newspaper contributors from each of the above sources, less deduction for projected operating costs and Cultural Fund .	
5. SOURCES OF DATA FOR DISTRIBUTION	Past payments to writers of articles published in newspapers and magazines who have retained entitlement to payments from Copyright Agency.		
6. NUMBER OF RECIPIENTS	There are approximately 4,300 recipients.		
7. NON-MEMBERS	There are no allocations to non-members.		
8. MINIMUM ALLOCATION	There is a \$10 minimum threshold.
