About the role

As part of a small, busy and productive team, the Senior Integration Developer is responsible for designing and developing integration solutions and implementing these in a new cloud-based AWS architecture with different SaaS solutions. The role works collaboratively with vendors and multiple business areas to ensure that all integration dependencies are understood, developed, documented and delivered to a tight schedule. This role is a 24-month contract and has been created as part of an exciting company-wide transformation project.

Duties

Your typical tasks and duties will include:

- gathering requirements across modules and their different systems for cloud, ERP and operations;
- designing and documenting complex architecture and adhering to integration patterns;
- developing integration solutions for a variety of use cases including SOA, middleware, bulk data, synch/asynch interactions and file-based solutions on iPaaS systems such as Dell Boomi and Mulesoft;
- developing ETL processes using AWS Glue and leveraging other AWS services such as S3, Athena and Lambada;
- documenting and mapping business and technical integration requirements; and
- mentoring junior team members.

About you

To be successful in this role, you will have:

- a strong background in complex integration projects with a wide variety of systems including ERP, Salesforce CRM, e-commerce platforms, finance and operational applications;
- an innovative approach with a commitment and dedication to working collaboratively;
- extensive knowledge and practice in enterprise integration patterns and their impact on performance, maintainability, scalability, extensibility and security;
- a clear, concise communication style with astute analytical skills and high levels of technical initiative;
- expertise in integration tools and middleware technologies (predominately Dell, Boomi and Mulesoft);

- extensive experience with SOA design in complex cloud environments;
- practical experience with enterprise integration including Salesforce, Dynamics and Business Process Management systems;
- experience building ETL solutions and data transformation pipelines with cloud-based tools, particularly AWS Glue;
- development experience with a wide variety of AWS for data storage, management and processing;
- excellent SQL skills across different database platforms;
- a demonstrated ability to execute complex database design, especially large scale cloud solutions, including NoSQL and document databases;
- solid technical understanding of current and emerging technologies;
- demonstrated experience delivering complex solutions in an agile environment;
- a demonstrated pattern of accountability in all facets of work;
- experience in mentoring junior staff; and
- demonstrated experience working in an Agile environment to a strict schedule and meeting deadlines.
