Background

This distribution is for fees from blanket licences for public galleries and museums for digital uses of artistic works from:

The galleries provide data about the artworks they have made digital uses of.

We also have pay-per-use licences for uses which are not covered by the annual blanket licence.

In 2025, the licence fees from the National Portrait Gallery were distributed separately, to the artists in the data provided.

- Larger distribution pool due to updated reporting and fees paid for the Apr24 Mar25 period
- Approx. 1,800 artists in the dataset, up from 1,000 last year due to increased usage coverage
