



Copyright Licence Religious Organisations

Religious organisations regularly copy and share published content in worship, study groups, children's activities and communications with their congregation. This can include articles, extracts from books, activity materials, poems, prayers and online content.

Most literary works are protected by copyright. If your organisation copies or shares material created by others, permission from the copyright owner may be required.

Copy and share content from around the world One licence covers literary content from millions of Australian and international sources*, including books, journals, newspapers, magazines and online publications.

Our Copyright Licence for Religious Organisations provides permission to copy and share literary content for worship, study groups, children's groups, religious education and other activities connected with worship or religious instruction.

Licence fees are returned to creators and publishers, helping support the creation of new content.

Why you might need a licence

- using published content in presentations, handouts or worship materials
- sharing articles or book extracts in study groups or other congregation gatherings
- photocopying pages from activity or colouring books for children's groups
- copying or sharing material from websites, books or other publications

Fee Structure

Licence fees for the Copyright Licence for Religious Organisations are simple:

- A flat licence fee of \$132.15 + GST* for religious organisations with an average weekly attendance of up to 100 attendees.
- \$134 + GST* per attendee for religious organisations with an average weekly attendance of over 100.

- **Use published content across religious activities.** Copy and share literary works in worship, services, gatherings, study groups and religious education.
- **Share content in print and digital formats.** Use published materials in presentations, handouts, newsletters and electronic communications with your congregation.
- **Save time seeking individual permissions.** One annual licence fee allows your organisation to copy and share content from millions of sources.
